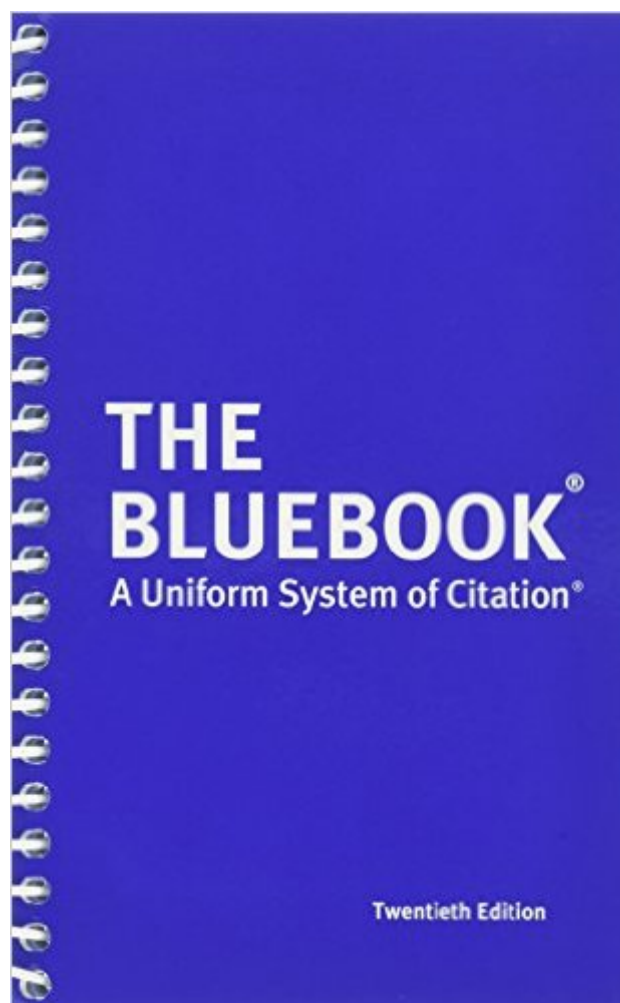


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This is a really important book to have...but the organization is SO TERRIBLE. It really is organized
