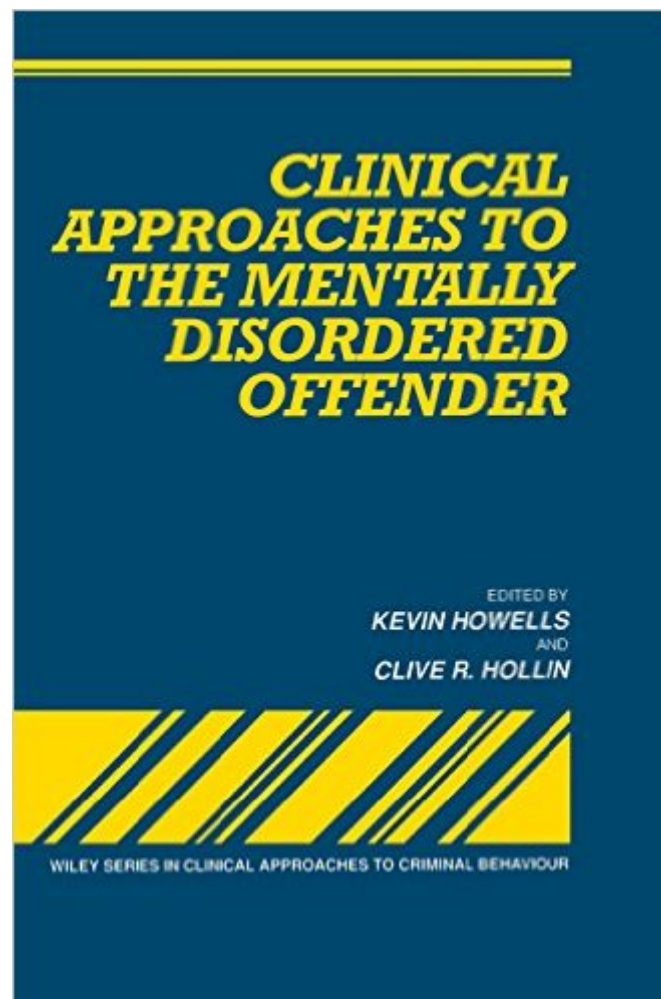


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Clinical Approaches To The Mentally Disordered Offender (Wiley Series In Clinical Approaches To Criminal Behavior)
